COMMUNITY: Horizon Science Academy Lorain serves the educational needs of Lorain Community. The School offers a K-12 grade level configuration. The student body is culturally diverse with a population that is 39.2% Hispanic/Latino, 30.8% White, 19.4% African-American, and 10.6% other.

SCHOOL: Horizon Science Academy-Lorain is a public charter school, which is funded by public sources and operated independently by a board of trustees under a charter granted by the Board of Education of the State of Ohio. Management of HSA-Lorain is served by Concept Schools NFP. HSA- Lorain is enrolling 684 students in grades K through 12. The purpose of the school is to provide its students an innovative world class education, rich in math, science and technology. The curriculum is college preparatory and focuses on STEM. The school opened in 2009 and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 2016. HSA-Lorain holds membership in the College Board and the National Association for College Admission Counseling.

CURRICULUM: HSA’s academic program is organized in an 8 period schedule. Students can earn 8 credits per year, with eight 42 minute classes. A minimum of 27 credits are required for graduation. In addition to that, each student must complete 40 hours of community service. Students earn 0.5 credits per semester or 1 credit a year for each class they take.

GPA AND RANKING: GPA is computed using the above chart. All credits whether passed or failed are included in computing grade point average and class rank. Grades are recorded on the transcript, and class rank and grade point average are computed in January and June.

College Credit Plus (CCP):

Working with Lorain County Community College, CCP is offered to all eligible students in grades 7 through 12. Students can earn college credits while they are in high school.
