Dear Students and Parents,

College Credit Plus (CCP) provides students in grades 7-12 with the opportunity to take college classes offered by any Ohio public college or university, or from any participating private postsecondary institution, at their high school, on the college or university campus, or online. The program allows students to explore college interests sooner and to earn college credits toward a degree before graduating from high school. It is free to families when students take courses offered by Ohio public colleges and universities.

Beginning February 15, public high school students may notify their principal of their interest to participate, and must declare their intent to participate by April 1. This includes students who participated in any or all of the first three years of College Credit Plus.

In an effort to give more students and families the opportunity to save on the cost of college, CCP now includes a Summer term. Credits earned by taking courses through CCP during a Summer term will be applied to students' high school and college transcripts during Fall.

If you are planning to register for any CCP offerings in 2020-2021 school year, make sure to return "the letter of intent" in this packet. Deadline to submit the form is April 1, 2021; return the signed form to your College Counselor at room #162.
