Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome to the 3rd quarter! For those of you returning to in person learning, we are so excited to see you next week. For those of you staying remote we miss you and hope you are doing well. I am writing to remind you of a few things for next week for both our in person learners as well as our online learners. Attached is your academic schedule and our current bell schedule (located on the back of this letter). Please make sure you review it before next week and know what times you need to be online if you are an online learner. Our school day is from 8:45am-1:30pm. **You must log in for attendance purposes to ConceptSIS by 8:55am-this has changed from the previous quarters.**

Online learners:

It is expected that you log on during your scheduled class times that correlate with the new bell schedule. You should be live learning with your classmates each period as they are in person. If you are unable to attend a class session at that time, we highly recommend that your child watches the missed recorded lesson that is posted in your child’s Google Classroom. Some of your teachers will be using Google Meets while others will use Zoom. You must go into their Google classrooms each day at your schedule time and view their links for each live session. This is a procedure that was implemented the first half of the year, so you should be familiar with finding your live session links.
