K-12 Summer School Outline

- **K-8 will be June 7, 2021-July 1st, 2021**
- **High School June 8 start and will be an additional two weeks and end July 15th**
- **Monday -Thursday/ Friday's off**
- **8:30a.m.-1:00p.m.**
- **Breakfast and lunch will be provided.**
- **Busing transportation will be provided upon request for ALL grades.**



Transportation

Car Riders:

- Dropped off at 8:30am and pick up with car visor tag at 1:00p.m.


Busing:

- Mask required on bus to/from school
- Be at stop 5 minutes prior to pick-up
- Email has been sent by First Student with information we have on file in CSIS
- First Student will notify you of route location, pick-up/drop off times etc...




COVID Procedures

- Stay at home when sick
- You must wear a mask/face covering daily to enter
- Practice social distancing when possible
- Wash your hands for 20 seconds
- Utilize hand sanitizing stations upon entry/exiting
- Surfaces will be cleansed regularly
- Avoid physical contact as much as possible




COVID-19 RESPONSE SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS

DO NOT ENTER



Do not enter if you have a fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell.


FACE COVERING REQUIRED



Mask Bandana Scarf Neck Gaiter


When in school (public) spaces, wear a face covering over your nose and mouth.

MAINTAIN YOUR DISTANCE



Maintain at least six feet of physical distance from others.


WASH YOUR HANDS OFTEN



20 SEC


Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If not possible, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.

AVOID PHYSICAL CONTACT



Do not shake hands or engage in unnecessary physical contact.

CLEAN SURFACES



Clean high-touch surfaces frequently with disinfectant.

K-8 Expectations.....

- **Students must attend 90% of the summer school program.**
- **Students in K-5 will receive instruction in Math & Language Arts.**
- **Students in grades 6-8 will receive instruction in Math, Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies.**
- **Students must attend in person learning. There will NOT be a remote summer school option.**
- **Students must successfully complete the summer school program in order to be considered for promotion, and must show growth on their pre/post assessments.**
- **At the end of the Summer program we will review attendance and student data to finalize confirmation of promotion/retention.**

High School Expectations....

- **High School students only, will not need to report until Tuesday, June 8th**
- **Students must attend 90% of the summer school program.**
- **Students will receive instruction through TRECA in the course of study they have failed during the 20-21 school year. If the student failed multiple courses, contact our College Counselor for guidance on summer work load.**
- **Courses enrolled will impact students transcripts and overall GPA, so active student engagement/serious approach is required.**
- **Students must attend in-person learning. There will NOT be a remote summer school option.**

High School Expectations....

- High School families must register online through our partner TRECA by June 3rd.

- Students need to meet with their online TRECA advisor regularly and consult with their HSA teachers for specific questions, concerns, or additional help needed.
- Online TRECA program is scheduled for 6 weeks but may take longer depending on students pacing through the curriculum.
- The focus is credit recovery to get students back “on-track” for graduation.
- Transcript will be provided upon successful completion through TRECA

Behaviors

We will follow typical school day expectations and procedures.

- Student handbook will be followed and enforced when necessary
- Parents will be contacted for any significant behavior issues

Dress Code

Students may dress down.

- Shorts and skirts must be at fingertip length.
 - No crop tops.
 - No holes in jeans.
 - No Pajamas/slippers.
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Dismissal.....

- **Transportation changes need to be made by 11am to Family Connection Team.**
- **Dismissal will be the same as a regular school day and will be prompt at 1:00p.m.**
- **Car visor tags will still be needed for K-5 students.**
- **6-12 students will exit the building as normal to their rides.**
